Attached is the application* for The Pavilion PARTners Fine Arts Scholarship. This scholarship is available to graduating seniors from Conroe ISD, Spring ISD, Klein ISD, Magnolia ISD, Montgomery ISD, Tomball ISD, Willis ISD, MacArthur and Carver High Schools in Aldine ISD, and private schools within those districts' boundaries. Applicants must intend to major in the Fine Arts, may apply in only one talent area, and must be a U.S. citizen or eligible resident.

Scholarship Information:

1. Fine Arts are defined as:
 - Dance (traditional, i.e., ballet, tap, modern, jazz)
 - Instrumental Music
 - Vocal Music
 - Theatre Arts
 - Visual/Graphic Arts
2. Scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:
 - 75% Talent/Audition
 - 25% Academic
3. Qualified applicants must audition in person. Auditions will be held the first week in **March**. Notice of your audition requirements as well as the date, time and location of your audition will be mailed during the month of **February**.
4. All applicants will be notified of reward decisions by letter by **mid-April**.
5. All scholarship monies will be paid directly to the college or university in which the recipient enrolls.
6. Scholarship recipients may be invited to perform at a Pavilion PARTners meeting or fundraising event.
7. Applications may be obtained by going to www.woodlandscenter.org , *The Pavilion PARTners Volunteers - Scholarship Information*. Follow the links to the New Application and print out the on-line information and application. All applications must be returned to your counselor by **February 1, 2011**. Only completed applications will be considered. ***Applications will not be accepted after the February 1 deadline.***
